


Core work packages

 - Annotation of RD within ICD11 coding
 - Extend availability of Orphanet nomenclature and its uptake
 - Cross referencing and update of international nomenclatures



Updates – wp 4 (national plans)

- EUROPLAN 2 website (<u>www.europlanproject.eu</u>)
- First inception workshop held September 2012
 - Establish working groups to define key indicators for evaluating RD initiatives using a Delphi methodology
 - First conferences have just taken place (organised by EURORDIS)



Updates – wp 5 & 7


- Wp 5: Codification of RD
 - ICD11 alpha draft completed, beta draft in progress
 - Adoption of the Orphanet nomenclature in the ICD11 framework is in progress
 - Workshop held (Sept) on cross-referencing with other terminologies.
- Wp 7 Quality Assurance in RD healthcare
 - Developing a qualitative research strategy, tools and methodologies for collection and validation of relevant information
